and elder at the First Presbyterian Church of Chicago Heights, IL and was a member of the choir. Carroll sang with the First United Methodist Church Choir in Lansing, IL and Park Forest Singers, now Grand Prairie Singers. He was also known as "Mysterious Smith", the magician.
