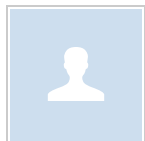

“ We were saddened to learn of Dolores's passing.  
I remember vividly the first time I saw Dolores. My mother ( Grandma Ross) and my sister , Lorraine had got wind of brother Joe's budding romance ...  
( he was 15 or 16 years old). In the summer a local park ( Avalon Park) had dances on their outdoor basketball court every Wednesday . They suspected Joe might have a special girl at these dances . So that night Lorraine , and her husband Jack, GrandMa Ross and I got into car ( I must have been 8 or 9 yrs. old and got dragged everywhere)and drove to Avalon Park . When we got there the place was packed. When they spotted Joe with Dolores jitterbugging ... Lorraine and Jack decided to dance up to them ...( the next record was a slow dance ) and Joe & Dolores were dancing close and gazing into each other's eyes oblivious to anyone else. When Lorraine said , " Oh - Hi Joe" he turned beet red and the space between he and Dolores widened.  
He had no choice but to introduce her to everyone. From that moment they were in our lives as a couple... a romance that lasted over 44 years until Joe died at the too young age of 59 .
