But I was definitely contacted on more than one occasion because the kitchen continued to send her unacceptable eggs in the morning. And the supply-line of Ensure wasn't quite up to speed. So my brother Dave actually had a case of Ensure delivered to the rehab center for her. We of course were locked out during the last seven or so days before she passed. But we made sure she knew she wasn't alone and that we were with her every step of the way. We did our best to educate the cooking staff how to prepare a decent scrambled egg. She actually ate half of her breakfast the previous morning. My compliments to the chef.

Mom doesn't have to worry any more. She's in good hands. May she rest in peace.
