Max Edward Mohler passed away peacefully on May 30, 2012. Born Oct. 17, 1938. He served his country in the United States Army from 1961 to 1964, being honorably discharged at the rank of Second Lieutenant.

Max began his career with Arthur Andersen (Chicago) in 1964, working in their small business division. From there he joined Wirtz Corporation (1975), carrying the title of Senior Vice President up until the time of his passing. He felt blessed to work with the Wirtz family for almost forty years and cherished the relationships he developed over his career.
