It was a great shock when I was informed of Susan's passing, and my thoughts and prayers are wiith you and your family.

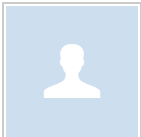
It appears in hindsight, that your retirement was providential in that you were able to focus 100% of your time and energies on being with Susan during her illness.
